

Welcome to lots of new members, I trust you'll enjoy your Harley & HOG experiences.



I have been working on a few bikes lately and have wondered what the hell these little bell's are for, and what they do. (Thinking they may be something like Peter Brocks energy polarizer) But after asking a few people, I think I have worked out the story, and no it's not about performance, but one of intrigue.

So here's how the little bell works and it's more than a decorative piece, it has a specific function. As we all know life has many mysteries that have no apparent solutions. 
